A jug and a sugar bowl - a coffee service. Their domed bodies rest on wide, decorative feet. Two paired handles emerge from the belly of the sugar bowl, while the coffee pot features a long pouring spout and a finely finished handle. Both vessels are topped by a lid adorned with a small apple-shaped knob. Set made by silversmith Alphonse Debain. Alphonse Debain - Parisian silversmith, who ran his workshop from 1911 to 1916 at 20, rue Rambuteau. He came from a family of goldsmiths. He specialized in the manufacture of high-quality dinner services. France, 1911-1916. Silver, title 950. Dimensions of sugar bowl: 16.5 cm x 21 cm x 15.5 cm. Dimensions of pitcher: 23 cm x 23 cm x approx. 14 cm. Weight of sugar bowl: 468 g. Weight of pitcher: 570 g. Condition: very good.
