Description

Period albumen print, dry stamp. Martyrs' Square, Naples. The monument sits enthroned in the center, flanked by four sculpted lions and surrounded by a richly decorated wrought-iron gate. In the background are buildings typical of Italian architecture of the period, suggesting a lively urban environment. Several figures, including men and children, are depicted in the street and on the sidewalk, observing the monument. The Piazza dei Martiri is a historic square in Naples, opened in the 17th century, and its central monument (a column surmounted by a statue symbolizing the Virtue of Martyrs) was erected as a tribute to Neapolitans who died for freedom. The four lions at its base represent historical periods linked to the Neapolitan "martyrs", notably between 1745 and
