Beautiful oil on canvas by Albert Malet depicting a gate under the snow, signed lower left + titled on the back "Neige à Gouville". Size of the painting alone out of frame 35x27cm and 51x43cm including frame. In perfect condition, delivered in a modern frame with black patina. Genuine work guaranteed. This is a superb post-impressionist composition by Albert Malet, who here paints an extract of a garden under the snow with a staircase and gate, located in Gouville. His technique is emblematic, with broad strokes in the manner of Albert Marquet and a most delicate palette of whites, mauves, ochres, browns, yellows and blacks.... September 4, 1986 in Rouen, was a French painter of the Rouen School. A student of Robert Antoine Pinchon, Albert Malet began painting in 1931. He took part in exhibitions organized by the Société des artistes rouennais. He exhibited three works at the Salon de l'école française at the Palais de Tokyo in Paris in 1942. Albert Malet is buried in Claville-Motteville, where he was a schoolteacher from 1947 to 1960. He exhibited on numerous occasions: Galerie Legrip, Rouen, 1941, 1942, 1943 1974: Centenaire de l'Impressionnisme, Albert Malet, Galerie Claude Marumo, Paris, June 7-30, 1974 Galerie Marumo, Paris, July 1974 Galerie Marie-Jeanne Garoche, Paris, December 1996 - January 1997. Galerie de la Cour d'Albane, November 1997. Albert Malet retrospective, Hôtel de Bourgtheroulde, Rouen, 2006. Impressionist Normandy - Albert Malet, Le Grenier à sel, La Bouille, August-September 2010 Festival Normandie impressionniste - Hommage à Albert Malet, Petit-Couronne, September-October 2010 A school in Limésy was named after him. A street in Barentin bears his name. A residence in Saint-Ouen-du-Breuil, where he spent his childhood, bears his name. A street in the Canada residence in Quincampoix-Fleuzy (Oise) is named after him.
