Description

Scandinavian secretary desk Arne Wahl Iversen model 69 1960s Important Danish secretary desk attributed to Arne Wahl Iversen, model 69, emblematic of Scandinavian modernist furniture of the 1960s. The architectural composition, remarkably sober, combines a wide central flap with a series of small side drawers and an airy base with subtly taut curved lines. The whole testifies to the functional refinement typical of Danish design in this period, seeking visual elegance, ergonomics and quality of execution. The wood features the beautiful flamed and ribboned grain typical of Danish teak, with warm variations from honey-brown to coppery-brown. The front reveals particularly lively, almost undulating patterns, carefully selected during the veneering process to create a

graphic continuity throughout the cabinet. The recessed carved handles and small turned knobs contribute to the organic aesthetic characteristic of high-end Scandinavian furniture from the 1950s-1960s. The structure is made of solid teak and teak veneer, with the interior featuring drawers and storage in light-colored wood, in accordance with Danish custom at the time. Model 69 is a perfect illustration of Arne Wahl Iversen's work: a quest for balance between modernist rigor and domestic warmth. The proportions are particularly successful, with a slender silhouette resting on straight, slightly tapered legs that visually lighten the volume. The overall design evokes the productions of the great Danish editors of the period, in the spirit of creations by Kai Kristiansen, Omann Jun or Sibast. The facade acts almost as an abstract composition where veining becomes living matter. Long horizontal lines structure the space, while sculpted handles create a discreet, elegant rhythm. The light catches the teak fibers beautifully, reinforcing the feeling of warm depth typical of quality Nordic furniture. The enfilade from the same source for sale in our other listings.
