Illegible annotations on the back. France late 19th century. Very good condition. Lively, poignant work. Alphonse Marie Deneuille, known as Alphonse de Neuville, born May 31, 1835 in Saint-Omer (62) and died May 18, 1885 in Paris 17th, was a French military draughtsman, illustrator and painter. A pupil of François Édouard Picot, he was one of the leading exponents of 19th-century military painting. He became famous for paintings depicting the Franco-Prussian War of 1870-71.
