Description

Rectangular snuffbox decorated with a multitude of geometric motifs. The four-sided lid features an elaborate figurative scene depicting a bourgeois company dancing. Framed by a leafy border, this composition testifies to the refined decorative talent of the craftsman. This box comes from the workshop of Louis Alexandre Bruneau, a Parisian silverware maker active in the mid-19th century. His work is featured in the permanent exhibition of the Victoria and Albert Museum in London. **Punca:** Minerva head, post-1838. **France, circa 1850. Silver, title 800. Niello, gilding. Dimensions:** 2 cm x 9 cm x 5 cm. **Condition:** good.
