### Description

Pair of dueling swords - France, circa 1830-1840. Leather-covered spindles wrapped with steel filigree. Steel olive knobs. Steel bivalve guards and thick, stiff leather protectors on the fuse side. Three-sided blued and gilded blades on the first third. At the base of the blades, on the side of the widest hollow panel, is a gilded cartouche with the initial W. This signature is that used by the workshops of the weyersberg family (Solingen) circa 1830-40. Wear and oxidation on the blue and gold. Oxidation on the steels. Guards have some play. The whole remains solid and quite presentable. Weight 445gr and 438gr. Length 110cm. Blade length 91cm.
