The Gashghai or Qashqai are nomadic tribes who live mainly in the province of Fars, particularly in the city of Shiraz in southwestern Iran. "Kilim" is a Turkish word for the flat-weaving technique (or tapestry). This carpet-making technique is different from the knotted-stitch technique (velvet look), the result is softer and lighter. Just as resistant as knotted-stitch carpets, Kilims are carpets in their own right, made to be laid on the floor, not just on walls. Contact me for more information and sales conditions.
