Important academic study of a male nude, attributable to the Florentine school between the late 18th and early 19th century. The standing figure, shown with a staff and drapery, presents a profile with wavy hair and moustache, a detail that gives the model a particularly vivid and individual presence.

Large sheet of fine antique paper prepared with tempera: the brushstrokes used by the artist to tone the surface before executing the drawing
