Engraving of Beethoven proof number 125 signed Léa Wahl Fontaine early 20th 1910 Created by French painter & designer Léa Wahl Fontaine, (1867-1940), this framed engraving depicts Ludwig Van Beethoven, renowned 19th-century German artist-composer, conductor and pianist. Numbered 125 and signed in his hand in pencil lower right, the whole framed in a baroque wood & gilded stucco frame. Léa Wahl Fontaine's work is typically academic & neoclassical, the artist's only freedom being the capture of emotions in the moment. Beethoven is shown aged, his clothes jerky, his hair loose and mussed. His gaze skyward, his face closed, summing up Beethoven's free spirit and life force, marked by a difficult childhood and deafness that would not prevent him from creating the finest
