Description

Wakizashi with shinto blade, mid-Edo period (1603-1868). Saya covered in polished and lacquered shagreen (same), the tsuka covered in coarse-grained shagreen (black braided), the iron tsuba made of two saddle-shaped elements adorned with gilded copper-inlaid grapevines. Fuchi-kashira in shibuichi or shakudo with nine galloping horses in shakudo and gold on nanako-ji background, kogatana with decorative signature (probably Seki Kanetsune ???), with a kozuka in shakudo with three galloping horses inlaid in shakudo and gold.(No signature)L. 66, 5 cm totalGold and silver maki-e lacquered conservation scabbard of seven different kamon (coat of arms) on a nashiji background. Grey-yellow mordor wild silk cases.Additional
