Description

Art Deco plaster bust of Ludwig Van Beethoven signed Ugo Cipriani early 20th century. Created by Italian artist-sculptor Ugo Cipriani (1887-1960), this "Terre cuite d'art" bust from the Art Deco period (1910-1939) depicts the bust of Ludwig Van Beethoven, renowned 19th-century German composer. After studying at the Beaux-Arts in Florence, Ugo Cipriani was prolific from the 1920s onwards, particularly after his exile from Mussolini's Fascist Italy to France. It was in Paris that he became known and appreciated for his Art Deco sculptures with geometric faces and a nervous mass of hair. These codes can be found in this important plaster sculpture of Beethoven, where Cipriani has captured the essence and strength of Beethoven's character: a strict genius caught in the storm of his emotions, marked by
