Mario Bellini x Zaccagnini & Figli, "Rearing Horse," ceramic, signed, 20th century This sculpture is a magnificent example of the craftsmanship of the Mario Bellini x Zaccagnini & Figli workshop. The "Cavallo Rampante" perfectly embodies the sculptural dynamism that made the Sesto Fiorentino production famous, especially during the period when the artistic direction of Urbano Zaccagnini and the collaboration of sculptors such as Fosco Martini steered the company toward an expressive and modern naturalism. The posture is extremely dynamic, with a twist of the neck that conveys a sense of theatrical movement, typical of the Art Deco style influenced by the Baroque. Material

and Technique: Cast ceramic with glossy white monochrome glaze. The "mirror" finish enhances the volumes and anatomical details, allowing light to play on the sculpted surfaces. Stylistic Details: The mane and tail are rendered with vibrant, flowing locks, almost "flaming," evoking the distinctive style of the 1930s and 1940s in the manufacturer's work.
