



Pair Of Louis XVI Sconces, 18th Century.

Description

These elegant gilded bronze sconces are from the Louis XVI period, they have two arms of light, the upper part supports a fire pot adorned with a garland and the lower part ends in a seed. The reverse side of the bobèches are petal-shaped and the binnacles are fluted. They are slightly worn on the protruding parts. Very small holes have been drilled in the bobèches between the petals for the passage of very fine wires. They are almost invisible. Eighteenth-century period. Height 40 cm.
