Charming blackened wood and repoussé brass pareclose mirror, Louis XIII style, dating from the late XIXe century. This refined model features a beveled mercury central glass, framed by four parecloses also with mercury, bringing depth and luminosity to the ensemble. The rich repoussé brass frame is adorned with finely worked gadrooned motifs, palmettes, scrolls and plant arabesques. The openwork pediment is centered with a mascaron featuring Minerva, Roman goddess of arts, crafts and wisdom, surrounded by abundant ornamentation inspired by the plant kingdom. The gilded copper elements, stamped and then applied to a wooden structure, bear witness to a fine decorative work
