There's no front or back, as the seam construction is perfectly symmetrical, allowing you to turn the dress as you please! Skilful smocking of pleats on the bust and buttoned cuffs. The black silk thread embroidery features diamonds and stars. The inside pocket bottoms are in brown burlap (fabric repairs). This dress must have been carefully preserved, as it shows no signs of wear and the indigo linen buckram has retained its original luster and glaze. No flaws. Very good color and condition. Rare
