This elegant clock embodies all the decorative poetry of the 19th century, from the late Napoleon III period.

A chubby young cherub, rendered with exquisitely soft modeling, leans carefree against the clock's case, in a pose that is both tender and lively. His raised, almost suspended gesture seems to reach out to caress or hold the two doves perched atop the clock, timeless symbols of innocence, peace, and love.

The decoration, rich without being excessive, plays on the harmony of volumes: supple drapery envelops the circular

base of the domed white
