



18th Century Silk Fragments



Description

Two fragments of brocaded silk on a satin ground decorated with flowers, stripes and a curious sinuous ribbon, alternating lace and feather effect. Were these two fragments removed from a dress? Maybe they were used in furnishing? The cut-out shape suggests that of a bergère. One of the two fragments seems to have taken on more dust, and is a little less fresh. It has a halo on the left-hand side (see photo). But generally in good condition. Good structural condition. It could be reused for a cabriolet upholstery. Height 75 cm by 86 cm Height 60 cm by 75 cm Plus 30 cm by 30 cm twice (the sides of the fragment)
