Art nouveau sweets basket in sterling silver 800 thousandths and blue crystal. Elegant Art Nouveau-style sweet basket, resting on a fine 800-thousandth solid silver frame, adorned with superb stylized female figures. The women's faces, treated in a typically naturalistic, vegetalized spirit, are set against a flowing decor of flowers and sinuous lines characteristic of the Art Nouveau movement of the late 19th - early 20th century. The finely crafted mount frames a magnificent original cobalt-blue crystal vessel, whose depth of color contrasts beautifully with the brilliance of the silver. The movable handle contributes to the overall elegance of the piece and gives it a particularly decorative silhouette. The set bears an Austro-Hungarian import hallmark of 1903 for the 800 thousandth
