Description

Large "Chalice" ceramic vase signed Ettore Sottsass for Bitossi Montelupo, an iconic piece of Italian design from the 1980s. Height 47cm, width 16cm. The base of the vase has been professionally glued back together (virtually invisible repair). SOTTASS Ettore (1917-2007) Architect and designer, he occupied a prominent place in Italian design from the 1950s onwards. In the 60s, two trips - to India and the USA - turned his worldview upside down. His experiences, both mental and physical, gave rise to the *Céramiques des ténèbres et des lumières* series, works with simple forms - circle, line, cylinder - inspired by Tantrism. Founder of the Memphis group in 1981, Sottsass is a major figure of 20th-century design.
