Description

Oil on panel 19th century panel depicting a Napoleonic cavalryman beside his prancing horse, in a dramatic and eventful composition. This military scene, treated with vigor and a sense of movement, clearly inspired by the great French Romantic compositions, particularly the work of Théodore Géricault. The figure, dressed in a cavalry uniform with breastplate, plumed helmet, is depicted in a heroic attitude typical of Napoleonic iconography. The vivid brushstrokes and luminous contrasts reinforce the theatrical character of the whole. Beautiful decorative painting with a strong presence, presented in an elegant wooden frame and gilded stucco with palmettes in the Empire style. Epoque: XIXth century. Epoque: 19th
