Wool-on-wool Sumak technique. Make no mistake, this fragment represents the highest refinement in weaving as well as in finesse of execution. The motif composed of series of stylized flowers in successive oblique bands is very rare. A true collector's item. Impeccable condition. Vegetal colors of unprecedented freshness. Circa 1880. Dim : 100 x 43 cm. If, like us, you are in awe of such objects, you should know that our collection includes around one hundred Maffrash, complete, around twenty, the rest in the form of fragments.
