She studied at the Académie de Liège and soon specialized in painting gardens, flowers, landscapes and seascapes. Angelina participated in the salons des artistes français from 1908 to 1929, receiving a mention. She was awarded the "Order of Leopold". Numerous exhibitions in Europe and England brought her international renown. She was one of the few female painters to make a living from her art. Museums: Ghent, Liège, Arlon, Luxembourg Angéline Drumaux's floral compositions are always bursting with color and freshness. her flowers are painted in full light.
