Rare and complete set of parade harness for draft horse, magnificent testimony to rural folk art of the late 19th or very early 20th century. This festive set includes the complete headpiece, a wrought-iron bit with barrettes and a leather grelottière with its original clear-sounding bronze bells. The major interest of this piece lies in its two rigid leather eyecups, edged with brass studs, each adorned with a superb embossed brass plaque featuring Saint Éloi. The patron saint of blacksmiths and protector of horses is depicted in episcopal vestments, wearing his mitre, holding his crozier and hammer, he has become the universal patron saint of all those who work with metal: goldsmiths, blacksmiths, metallurgists, mechanics, and here of
