Description

This elegant pair of French bergère armchairs, dating from the late 19th century, showcases the enduring refinement of the Louis XV style combined with remarkably solid craftsmanship. Heavily constructed and of very good quality, the chairs feature beautifully carved walnut frames with graceful cabriole legs, floral carvings, and elegantly shaped arm supports typical of fine French seating from the period. The rich walnut wood displays a warm patina and attractive grain, highlighting the quality of the carving and the substantial nature of the frames. Generously proportioned with deep seats and enclosed upholstered sides, these bergères are exceptionally comfortable and inviting, equally suited to a formal salon, library, or sophisticated bedroom interior. The chairs retain their

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decorative coral-pink upholstery adorned with woven floral motifs in soft golden tones, finished with traditional brass nailhead trim. The upholstery presents gentle wear consistent with age and use. One of the bergères shows visible wear to both armrests, visible in the photographs and video, which remains in keeping with the authentic character and history of the pieces. Elegant, comfortable, and beautifully made, this pair offers the timeless charm of French late 19th-century decorative arts.
