Each jug is beautifully proportioned with a generous, rounded crystal body rising into a tall, slender neck, creating a refined and balanced silhouette. The shoulders are encased in solid silver mounts, intricately hand-engraved with scrolling foliate decoration, acanthus leaf motifs, and fine linear detailing. A delicate beaded border frames the transition between metal and glass. The handles are particularly distinctive, formed in an elegant scroll design and incorporating subtle
