Description

A generous Provencal farmhouse table in elm, weathered and dating from around 1850. This long table embodies the authenticity of 19th-century French rustic furniture, where sturdiness and natural materials were thought to last for generations. Originally stained white, it has recently been sanded, revealing the warm shades of elm beneath subtle traces of its former finish. These touches of white create a subtle, nuanced patina, giving the surface depth, texture and a unique wabi-sabi charm. The three drawers (as deep as the table's width) on the front add both functionality and visual harmony, while the legs feature simple carved details typical of Provencal furniture of the period. Light marks of use, testifying to its age and history, contribute to the piece's authenticity. With its generous
