A German-speaking painter active around the turn of the 19th century. The work belongs to the trompe l'oeil letter-rack tradition, a compositional genre with deep roots in Northern European painting, in which cards, prints, documents and printed ephemera are arranged in simulated disorder against a painted wooden background. The illusionistic rendering is precise and carefully observed: a French Revolutionary assignat, an Austrian genealogical almanac, figural engravings, a landscape with a bridge, a gentleman's portrait and a small still life with a cat, fruit and vegetables are all depicted
