Description

- Oil on canvas. - Alberto Lobos (1892-1925) occupies a place imbued with romantic melancholy in the history of Chilean art. A major figure, he and his brothers introduced a premodern sensibility through their search for light and emotion. A member of the legendary Generation of 1913, Lobos broke away from rigid academicism to embrace a pictorial style characterized by vibrant brushstrokes and evocative atmospheres, where the landscape is not a mere reproduction of reality, but rather a reflection of the soul. His stay in Europe perfected his technique, enabling him to capture the fleetingness of the moment with almost impressionistic ease, making him a precursor of modernism in Chile. He demonstrated that the true avant-garde lay in the honesty of the eye and
