Striking 19th-Century Mahogany Campaign Filing or Drawing Cabinet, English circa 1890. This exceptionally well presented late Victorian mahogany campaign cabinet, dating from around 1890, was originally designed as a folio, map or filing chest and beautifully combines refined military style with superb practical storage. Made in solid mahogany with quality tongue-and-groove construction, it is a very rare example retaining all eleven of its original drawers and brass handles, arranged in an unusual configuration of six smaller drawers over five larger, graduated drawers. The rectangular top has a moulded edge and is inset with black tooled leather, giving the piece a smart and tailored appearance. The drawers are fitted with their original flush mounted brass campaign handles.
