The front features superb walnut burl veneer work, highlighted by delicately rounded corners and a sober, majestic silhouette typical of the Louis-Philippe style. The drawers are dovetailed and retain their elegant, finely chased brass escutcheons. A single key opens and locks the drawers. The piece rests on turned legs and is topped with a magnificent top
