Description

Old ovoid glass vase signed Jean-Simon Peynaud. Fine enameled lake scenery in sepia tones. Panoramic scenery animated by tree-covered islets, reflections on the water and a small fisherman's boat, treated with remarkable graphic delicacy. The "Peynaud" signature is visible at the base of the decoration. The set testifies to the refinement of French production in the years 1925-1935, in the spirit of the great artistic glassworks of the interwar period. Height: 20 cm. Qslight traces of use , no chips or cracks. Jean-Simon Peynaud (1869-1952) was a French glass artist renowned for his decorative creations in etched and enamelled glass during the Art Nouveau and then Art Deco periods. Based in Limoges, he developed a poetic universe inspired by lakeside landscapes, naturalistic
