Bronze sculpture with a dark patina, signed. Dimensions: 67 x 60 x 25 cm. An important sculpture depicting a knight and a lady in an intimate pose. The work highlights the artistic sensibility of Riccardo Ripamonti, a master of the Lombard sculptural tradition between the 19th and 20th centuries, capable of combining descriptive realism with intense emotional expression. The composition stands out for the dynamic balance of its volumes and the refined modeling of its surfaces: the vibrant treatment of the drapery and the equestrian figure lends movement and depth to the scene, while the brown patina enhances the anatomical details and the play of light on the bronze.
