Walnut frame with short barrel, wood with all brass fittings stamped with a crowned "P", stamped with the controller Jean Baptiste Pozon. Flint lock signed "Mre simple de St Étienne" stamped with the "J" under the controller Jean Baptiste Javelle's crown. Barrel 20.1 cm long, dated "1810", stamped "C et B" surmounted by a palmette of controller Antoine Blachon. Breechblock marked "Mlean 9", length with breechblock 24.3 cm. Iron ramrod with nailhead. Overall pistol length 35.5 cm. Caliber 17.5 mm. Wood marked "C.B. 1810" On one pistol trimmings 1? punched "P" crowned and on the other punched "H fleuron de Jean Baptiste Hardy, réviseur à St Étienne de 1810-1812. In good condition. France .
