These elegant decorative vases perfectly embody the neoclassical aesthetic associated with Louis XVI taste, blending symmetry, nobility of materials and ornamental richness. The marble, in shades of pink, cream and burgundy, features remarkable natural veining, beautifully enhanced by the warm contrast of finely chased gilded bronze. Each cassiolette is decorated with floral garlands, laurel motifs and superb ram heads, directly inspired by late 18th-century French decorative arts. The lids are surmounted by decorative grips that reinforce the vertical
