Various wood inlays featuring carnations (Spanish national flower) on the upper part of the backs. 100 x 42 x 50 cm each. With workshop metal plate on reverse "Juan Busquets - Ciudad 9 - Barcelona". Various wear due to age. Two slightly damaged on the back. Original tapestry on back. Provenances: - Presented by the designer at the VIth Barcelona International Art Exhibition in 1911.
