The top is molded and the three-tiered mahogany structure has a warm patina. The openwork uprights, each formed of four slats, typical of English revolving bookcases, give the piece of furniture a beautiful visual lightness. The various storage levels offer generous capacity for bound books, novels, paperbacks or decorative objects. The unit stands on four castors. The whole is distinguished by a balanced silhouette, characteristic of the late Victorian style, which fits equally well in a classic interior or in a contemporary setting seeking a piece of
