Painting, "Still life with flowers" in scagliola, 19th century Very fine decorative painting depicting a bouquet of flowers in a vase, accompanied by fruit and butterflies, executed in scagliola. Scagliola (from the Italian word "scaglia", meaning "splinters") is a technique for creating stucco columns, sculptures and other architectural elements that imitate inlays of marble and semi-precious stones. The scagliola technique emerged in 17th-century Tuscany as an effective alternative to costly marble inlays, the hard stone works produced for the Medici family in Florence.
