Description

This is an antique footed tazza or offering bowl, constructed from silver with a total weight of 685 grams. The object consists of an octagonal flared bowl mounted on a baluster stem and a circular flared base, measuring 18 cm in height and 21.5 cm in diameter. The interior of the bowl features a central circular medallion depicting a high-relief profile of a figure in traditional ceremonial dress. The eight sides of the bowl are divided into alternating panels; four panels contain embossed floral motifs, while the other four contain figural representations. The upper rim of the bowl is finished with a pierced and scalloped decorative edge. The baluster stem is embellished with raised floral medallions and a textured band near the bottom. The circular base is decorated with continuous, finely chased foliate
