Description

This 130th-anniversary collection flared vase is manufactured by Lalique in France and is constructed from a combination of satin-finished and re-polished clear crystal. It measures 29 centimeters in height and 34 centimeters in diameter, with a total weight of 9.6 kilograms. The exterior surface features a graphic arrangement of swallows in flight, each accented with hand-applied gold stamping. The design utilizes Lalique's signature contrast between transparent polished sections and textured, frosted satin areas which create a matte, translucent appearance across the sculpted motifs. The vessel has an asymmetrical, curvaceous silhouette where the figures of the birds are rendered in high relief with finely chiseled feather details.
