Ancient & beautiful Japanese polychrome ukiyo-e print depicting two elegant women dressed in sumptuous kimonos richly adorned with floral and decorative motifs. The scene, of great graphic finesse, deploys a refined palette dominated by the Prussian blues, vermilion reds and deep blacks characteristic of Japanese productions of the second half of the 19th century. The female figures, treated in the taste of bijin-ga, evolve in a stylized landscape animated by flowers and aquatic elements. The extraordinary arabesques of the fabrics and the richness of the motifs testify to the decorative refinement of the Utagawa school. Work, wood-engraved using the traditional nishiki-e technique. Japanese work from the late Edo period or early Meiji era, circa 1850-1880. Height: 52
