Description

Superb and authentic Empire period (early 19th century) painting depicting a bucolic genre scene: The Gardener at Work. This is a work of great finesse executed in mixed technique: the figures, trees and landscape setting are entirely embroidered in silk thread, while the sky and facial details are hand-painted on the silk backing. The work is presented in its magnificent period frame in wood and gilded stucco leaf, richly carved with palmettes and rais de coeur motifs, characteristic of the Empire style. The general state of preservation for a textile of this period. Well-preserved silk colors, original gilding of the frame with superb patina of age (normal wear and tear, see photos).
