### Description

This is a representation of Saint Augustine. The right hand on the heart and the luminous triangle "VERITAS" identify Saint Augustine, Doctor of the Western Church. The triangle is a representation of the divine trinity spreading truth, while the burning heart symbolizes God's love and the quest for truth. This is a work of mixed technique: fine silk embroidery and painting. This creation may date from the Restoration / Charles X period. This embroidery is part of a period marked by an intense revival of the Catholic faith and religious art in France at this time in history. The frame is Restoration-period molded and carved wood, stained walnut-style with large acanthus scrolls in high relief at the four corners. The whole is in good condition, note the slight lack of wood at
