Description

Rare and beautiful clock in sculpted marble and gilt bronze representing the bath of Venus at the waterfall, on a base sculpted with fluting and decorated with a scene of lovers in the clouds. It stands on six toupie feet. The enameled dial signed J. Beliard, rue du Hurpoix in Paris. The dial displays hours and minutes, two pierced brass hands and the minutes hand in blue steel. The movement is complete to restore (a spring?). Original bell and key, posterior wire pendulum. The marble sculpture in good general condition, old collage on one foot. Parisian work from the Louis XVI period XVIII th century. Bi il Julien Beliard, son of a clockmaker, worked with his father, whose workshop he took over on rue du Hurpoix in Paris. He received his master's degree in October 1786. He met with great success
