Description

Sarreguemines, suite of 6 dinner plates with polychrome decoration of chrysanthemums, roses, vine leaves, periwinkle and lace, on a form known as "Papier épingle" at the faïence factory. This particular form, which was only enhanced with the "Lavallière", "Sujets" (Froment Richard) and "fleurs Louis XV" decors, is characterized by trompe-l'oeil pinned paper folds. Note the cut-sided square shape of these plates. This marriage of form and decoration makes this one of the most elaborate services in Sarreguemines' rich tableware production. Print transfer and brush highlights. The first source encountered on this service is in the "Tarif des Produits Céramiques de Sarreguemines", no. 8, part 2, August 1893. Size - 23.30 x 23.30 cm Very good condition. Late 19th century.
