Description

Sarreguemines, set of 3 dessert plates decorated of chrysanthemums, roses, vine leaves, periwinkle and lace, on a form known as "Papier épingle" at the faïence factory. This particular form, which was only enhanced with the decors "Lavallière", "Sujets" (Froment Richard), "fleurs Louis XV", is characterized by paper folds pinned in trompe-l'œil. Note the square shape with cut sides of these plates. This marriage of form and decoration makes this one of the most elaborate of the rich tableware production in Sarreguemines. Print transfer and brush highlights. The first source on this service is found in the "Tarif des Produits Céramiques de Sarreguemines", No. 8, Part 2, August 1893. Size - 20 x 20 cm Very good condition. Late 19th century.
