A rare eye-catcher, this piece from Tabriz, Iran.## Hand-knotted under the Kadjar dynasty, second part of the 19th century. Wool & silk blends for velvet - Turkish knot. 90 knots over 10 cm width. 80 knots over 10 cm length. i.e. 720,000 knots per m². Fine cotton weave. Tabriz carpet with sixteen-pointed floral rosette and small pendants, designed as an imosant sixteen-petaled flower or transcription of the sun. This piece measuring 122 cm wide by 185 cm long. Original to Iran, this beautiful antique collector's rug features a finely crafted decoration to put more on the wall than on the floor. Sublime museum-quality collector's piece. Medallion designed like a sun, with pendants followed by three other small pendants. The whole is set on a plain bright red field. Characteristic color of Tabriz

This decoration repeats the design of the flowers on the medallion.## In very fine condition for its age, very slight wear evident, in high quality wool & silk, and soft colors combining wonderfully with the red of the field. This beautiful Persian rug takes up the criteria of ancient Persian decorations, knotted with great finesse. The quality of these Persian pieces is unquestionable, the work is fine, precise and durable. The materials used are first-rate: This rug is clean (impeccable), the wool is beautifully knotted and finely tightened as these rugs always are. It reveals shades full of contrasts, very many colors, blues, pinks, reds, greens, apricots, blacks and ivories. The nuances underline this skilful floral design in the great tradition of Persian art. A design also found in Mughal art, inspired by the miniatures of the Tabriz school, then capital of the Persian Empire. # Carpet knotted under the Kadjar or Kadjar dynasty (Qajar, Qadjar, Qajar, Persian: ?????) Turkmen dynasty that ruled Iran from 1786 to 1925.## For information: Tabriz (Azeri: Təbriz/ ?????, formerly Tauris), is the capital of the province of East Azerbaijan, northwest of Iran (Iranian Azerbaijan). Tabriz lies on the course of the Talkheh River (also called Aji-Chai), near Lake Ourmia, close to the borders of the Republic of Azerbaijan and Armenia. It is the gateway to Persia from the north to the west. Tabriz carpets are extremely important in the quality of Persian carpets and have a very high international reputation.
