Description

14k solid yellow gold open-face pocket watch featuring a mechanical movement by the American Waltham Watch Company. The internal case back is stamped with a 14K purity mark and the case serial number 39791. The inner dust cover is engraved with the retailer inscription "W. Scholly R'dam," indicating the piece was originally sold in Rotterdam, Netherlands. The case measures approximately 47mm in diameter, with a total length of 66mm including the crown and bow. The total item weight is approximately 75.3 grams. The external gold surfaces are finished with engine-turned engraving and include a vacant circular cartouche on the back cover. The white enamel dial is signed "American Waltham U.S.A. TRAVELER" and features black Roman numeral hour markers, a rail-track minute

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circle, and a subsidiary seconds dial at the 6 o'clock position. The hands are blued steel. The internal mechanical movement is a Waltham Traveler grade with 7 jewels and a manual crown-wind mechanism. The movement plates have a frosted gilt finish and are engraved with the serial number 18844815, which corresponds to a production date of approximately 1912. The timepiece is a keyless wind model with a top-mounted winding crown and a circular gold bow.
