A domed bowl decorated with heads of deities in relief. The whole is covered with a blue-azure ornamental motif representing a dragon walking among the clouds. China, Qing dynasty, 18th century. Underglaze painted ceramic. Height: 60 cm, diameter: 45 cm. Condition: some flaws at foot and casting. In Chinese culture, the dragon is a symbol of happiness, strength, power and wisdom. It is considered a beneficent creature, bringing positive energy, protection and prosperity. The dragon also symbolizes the masculine yang element; it is inseparable from water and imperial power, and is one of the twelve signs of the Chinese zodiac.
