Description

Aldo Nason for Mazzega, brass and Murano glass, 1970s Floor lamp by Aldo Nason for Mazzega, created in the 1970s. The piece is a refined example of Italian design from that period, in which the purity of modern lines is combined with the Murano tradition of craftsmanship. The slender, minimalist structure is crafted from satin-finished brass and rests on a circular base with a minimalist design. The upper section features three arched shades made of milky white Murano glass with subtle internal veining, elements that evoke organic forms and give the lamp a striking visual presence. The contrast between the soft luminosity of the glass and the warm finish of the brass creates a balance typical of high-end Italian production from the 1970s.
